EM Data on Buyers of Carbon Offsets

EM has long tracked the buyers of carbon offsets directly from a global network of hundreds of market participants reporting tens of thousands of current, historical, and future offset transactions through the EM Global Carbon Survey. This uniquely positions EM to be able to determine how demand-side preferences are reflected in prices, volumes, and the variety of core carbon and additional attributes that includes project location, project category & type, vintage, seller type, seller location, primary vs secondary market, buyer type, buyer location, contract delivery structure (e.g., spot, futures), standard, co-benefits, among others.


Important updates for the 2021 EM survey: New questions have been added to enable greater transparency of transactions, particularly for end buyers of carbon offsets, to also track use of offsets to meet specific voluntary commitments (e.g., net zero, carbon neutrality), the buyer's organization name, among other metrics.

Timeline for 2021

- When will the 2021 EM Global Carbon Survey be launched and what time period does it cover?
 - The 2021 survey when first launched in April will cover Calendar Year 2020 and YTD 2021.
 - Throughout the year, organizations will be prompted to update their organization's EM Global Carbon Survey profile with new transactions and deliveries.
 - Respondents will be able to access and update previous responses.

Completeness and Confidentiality

- I can't answer everything, are partial responses OK?
 - Yes, organizations can respond with as little or as much information as is available and possible.
- Due to confidentiality issues, I cannot share individual transaction details, is aggregate data OK?
 - EM understands the importance of keeping individual respondent data confidential and will furnish it in an anonymized & aggregated format.
 - Respondents are encouraged to provide information on individual transactions, however in some cases this is not possible, so respondents do have the option to roll up individual transactions.

Functionalities of the new online survey platform:

- Save before submitting?
 - Yes, you'll be able to access and save throughout.
- We have multiple people at my organization that will be completing various pieces of the survey, can we all access the same online survey profile?
 - Yes, this is possible however we encourage respondents to be cautious so as to not overwrite each other if logged in at the same time.
